

Tynan-Eyre 20th Anniversary

A ceremony was held on Monday 13 October to commemorate the anniversary of the death of Constables Damian Eyre and Steven Tynan, who were shot in South Yarra's Walsh Street twenty years ago.

Since then, the Victoria Police Blue Ribbon Foundation has been funding public health projects in their honour, including the Tynan-Eyre Diagnostic Centre at The Alfred.

The unit's MRI provides clinicians with highly accurate images capable of detecting small tumours and is used extensively for research. Funding by the Blue Ribbon Foundation has enabled the hospital to purchase enhancements to the MRI to aid with pre-surgical computer imaging, simulations and the accurate diagnosis of multiple sclerosis.

Constables Eyre and Tynan's families (pictured below) were presented with commemorative plaques to mark the occasion.
