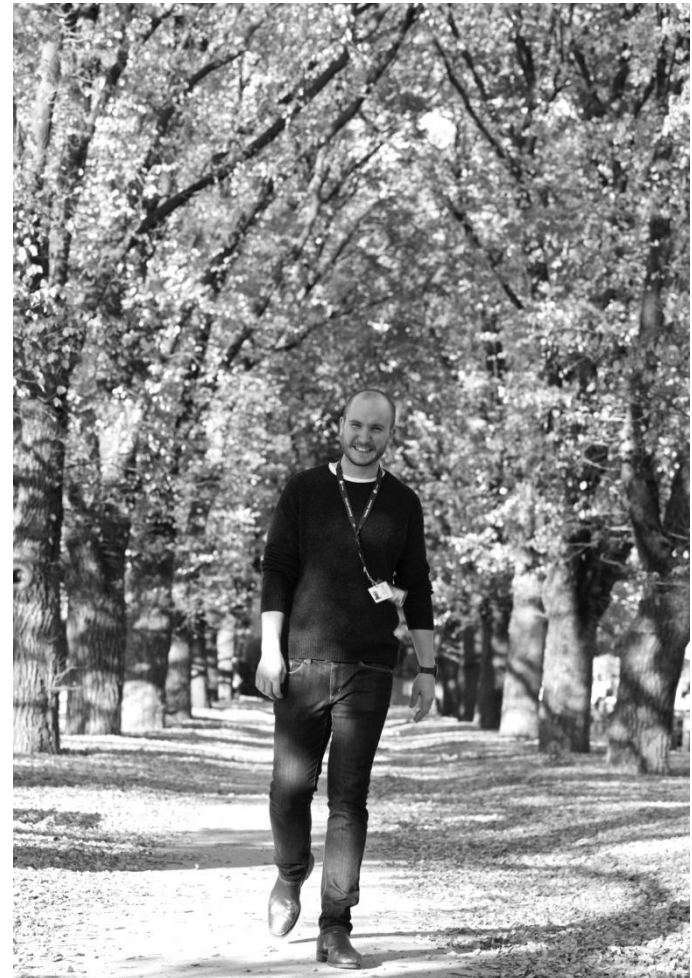


Structural Feedback
