

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF INFECTION

- Fever Temperature greater than 37.5 c
- Night sweats
- Shivering
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Persistent diarrhoea
- Any new discharge from a wound
- Burning sensation when passing urine
- New, severe or persistent headache
- New, severe or increasing shortness of breath
