



Allocation of Rotations


- MWU construct a 60 line rotation matrix that incorporate the minimum internship requirements

Rosters

- Interns are generally rostered 76 hour fortnights
- No rostered night shifts
- Published two weeks prior to the commencement of each term on Microsoft Teams
- Email notification from MWU coordinator with administrative orientation
- We accept roster requests





Annual Leave

- Interns are allocated 5 weeks of annual leave per annum
 - 2 weeks within Alfred Emergency Department term (requested via allocations process)
 - 3 weeks between the end of Intern year and commencement of HMO year
