FAQ's and Answers

Q.1 – What do I do if my Clinical Placements have been impacted by COVID -19?

A.1 – We appreciate that due to disruption to placements caused by COVID 19, some candidates may have to submit either second year appraisals or an appraisal from a community or mental health placement to ensure their application is complete. These candidates can then submit an updated third year appraisal if this placement is completed before closing date for applications.

Q.2 – What will the interview process for the 2022 graduate intake look like during COVID19 restrictions?

A.2 – There are no F2F interviews. All candidates will complete online video interviews on the PMCV Allocation & Placement Service (APS) website. There are practice questions available to candidates on this site as well to help you prepare for this requirement.

Q.3 – If offered a GNP position with Alfred Health, can you choose which campus/ward/start date?

A.3 – applicants are applying to Alfred Health which has 3 campuses, applicants have opportunity to nominate their preferences, all information will be considered but cannot be guaranteed.

Q.4 – I have never done a placement at Alfred Health, will this affect my application?

A.4 – No. Alfred Health welcomes applications from all eligible candidates.
