Alfred Health Nursing Professional Practice Framework

Alfred Health is a dynamic health service that values the contribution of nurses and their important place in healthcare. This is a quality workplace for talented, compassionate and smart nurses who want to practice nursing at its' highest levels and are ready to meet the demands in the ever-changing health system.

Patients and the community trust our nurses to deliver safe, appropriate care. We are a trusted profession and with that, comes a responsibility to practice nursing to the best of our ability. As individual nurses, we are each responsible for the safety and quality of our professional practice to ensure our care is safe, effective, integrated and evidence based.

We have developed the Alfred Health Nursing Professional Practice Framework to define the key elements of nursing practice. Our overall aim is to advance nursing practice to improve the care and experience of patients.

The Nursing Professional Practice Framework (Figure 1) is comprised of five domains that are crucial to maintain high standards, lead change and add value to health care. Comprehensive Care is the foundation domain. The remaining four domains underpin and support Comprehensive Care by building knowledge, expanding evidence based practice, innovating and leading improvements:

- 1. Comprehensive Care Every Patient. Every Time. (Foundation Domain)
- 2. Leadership
- 3. Professional Development
- 4. Research and Informatics
- 5. Workforce



Domains in Detail

5 domains of practice comprise the Nursing Professional Practice Framework



Comprehensive Care is evidence based and delivered in partnership with patients and families.

Comprehensive Care. Every Patient. Every Time (Figure 2) describes the foundations of nursing care.

The objectives of this domain include:

- Engage patients and families in improving care
- Ensure nursing provides a quality and safety approach to patient care
- Recognise and building on areas of success in clinical practice



Leadership is enabled and encouraged at all levels of nursing practice.

Through nursing leadership, we will provide a positive and supportive environment to deliver safe, high quality clinical care to patients.

The objectives of this domain include:

- Build courageous, responsive, competent and compassionate leaders
- Support nurses to be clear and able to contribute to our strategic direction and purpose
- Create a culture where leaders can emerge and grow



Professional Development is advanced through education, learning and training.

The objectives of this domain include:

- Create and embed a model of professional development
- Embed a patient centred culture in education and professional development
- Develop and implement an inter-professional education model
- Develop, collaborate and enhance relations with key partners and stakeholders



Research and Informatics advance our nursing practice.

The objectives of this domain include:

- Build capacity and training in research and practice
- Generate evidence and apply evidence to nursing practice
- Incorporate data into practice to support decision making




Resilience is evident in the Nursing Workforce Development to lead innovation and add value.
