What is Older Persons Care Hub?

The Older Persons Care Hub is a new, rapid-response service at Bayside Health providing short-term, multidisciplinary assessment and intervention for older people at risk of ED or hospital admission.

Our service aims to stabilise acute issues and support patients to remain at home when safe to do so. Patients are referred back to their GPs with a comprehensive care plan and community referrals where appropriate.

Who is Older Persons Care Hub for?

Older Persons Care Hub supports older people living in the catchment who are:

- Aged 65 years and over or,
- Aged 50 years and over for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people

Older Persons Care Hub supports older patients experiencing acute or emerging issues such as:

- Falls
- Delirium (with supports in place)
- Functional decline
- Medication-related issues
- Early exacerbations of chronic disease
- Other acute concerns requiring rapid multidisciplinary input


How to refer
