



## **VACCINATION AFTER HEART OR LUNG TRANSPLANT**

Following your transplant you should never be given any “**Live**” Vaccines, you should also avoid contact with anyone who has had the Sabin, Typhoid, or Chicken Pox vaccines in the last 10 days.

### **Live Vaccines which you should not be given :**

- Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- BCG
- Yellow Fever
- Oral Polio ( Sabin)
- Typhoid ( Typh- Vax Oral)
- Varicella Zoster VZV( Chicken Pox )

### **Vaccines which may be given:**

- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis
- ADT, CDT, Tet Tox, Triple Antigen
- Cholera
- Meningitis ( MencevacAC )
- Merieux Inactivated Rabies Vaccine
- Typhoid ( not oral Form )
- Hepatitis B ( Energix – B, HB Vax 11 )
- Hepatitis A
- Fluvax
- Pneumovax
- Poliomyelitis inactivated

All transplant recipients should have:

- **FLUVAX** - your first dose should be given at least 3 months after transplant followed by another dose 6 weeks later. This regime should be followed annually
- **PNEUMOVAX** – This vaccine should be given every 5 years
