

Good Clinical Practice (GCP) for all

An opportunity for all Alfred Health staff to participate in a free TransCelerate-accredited GCP course



Alfred Health is a member of Monash Partners Health Academic Health Science Centre – a collaboration between Monash University, health research institutes and clinical care providers. Monash Partners vision is to measurably enhance the health of the communities it serves.

As part of this collaboration Monash partners is providing Alfred Health staff the opportunity to participate in a TransCelerate-accredited GCP short course at no cost. All investigators involved in clinical research are required to have a current GCP certificate with updated training every 3 years.

Participants will gain an understanding of the requirements of ICH GCP and an awareness of how to conduct a study in accordance with ICH GCP. Accredited training in this area is expected by pharmaceutical companies that initiate commercially sponsored clinical trials, and this course is recognised as acceptable for this purpose.

Who should attend this training?

The training is suitable for staff with and without previous ICH GCP training and is designed for those involved in pharma or investigator-initiated clinical research, including Principal Investigators, Associate Investigators and Clinical Trial Coordinators. Alfred Health now expects that all researchers will complete GCP training.

Course outline

This is six hour, face-to-face training and consists of 5 modules:

- The Standards
- Study Set Up
- Informed Consent
- Case Report Form & Data Entry
- Safety Reporting

On successful completion of this course, attendees will receive a TransCelerate-accredited certificate of ICH GCP training.
